ORDER

The court has before it plaintiff’s unopposed motion to enlarge the deadline for defendant to respond to the complaint, by approximately six weeks, and to also enlarge plaintiff’s deadline to respond to any motion to dismiss filed by defendant, by approximately four weeks. The court finds that the requested enlargements of time are reasonable, but because the first proposed deadline conflicts with a federal holiday, it will be extended by an additional day. Plaintiff’s motion is **GRANTED**. Accordingly, defendant shall **FILE** its answer or other response to the complaint by **no later than Tuesday, January 17, 2023**, and should a motion to dismiss be filed on or before that date, plaintiff shall **FILE** its response to said motion by **no later than Friday, March 17, 2023**.
