ORDER

The court has before it the parties' joint status report filed January 19, 2023. The court stayed this case to allow the parties to pursue interlocutory appeals of the court's ruling on defendant's motion to dismiss. That appellate process has concluded. Pursuant to <u>Fairholme Funds</u>, Inc. v. United States, 26 F.4th 1274 (Fed. Cir. 2022), <u>cert. denied</u>, Nos. 22-99, 22-100, 2023 WL 124023 (U.S. Jan. 9, 2023), the parties state that "no further proceedings are necessary in this case [and that] this case should be dismissed with prejudice." Joint Status Rep. 2.

The court therefore **LIFTS** the stay in this matter, **DENIES as moot** plaintiffs' motion for joinder of nominal defendants, filed May 10, 2018, and **DISMISSES** plaintiffs' claims with prejudice. The Clerk shall enter judgment accordingly.
